### Meals

**Breakfast** – Students should eat breakfast at home.

**Lunch** – Parents provide a healthy lunch for their child. Students are to bring lunches in an insulated lunch box with drinks in a thermos, water, or juice in its container. Soft drinks, sodas, are not allowed in lunches. **Microwaves are not available to heat lunches.**

**Hot Lunch** – Most Fridays Hot Lunch is available to CBS students. An order form is sent home for parents to complete and return with payment if the student chooses to participate. Students can order a lunch from the featured vendor for the week. When the vendor brings the orders to school on Friday, PTO parents help serve hot lunches. Vendors such as Chick-fil-A, Fazoli's, Domino's, and Zaxby's are used on a rotating basis.

**Snacks** – K3 and K4 classes are given snacks daily. Snacks are served at ASP also.

### **Wednesday Chapel Services**

All students participate in a mid-week chapel program on Wednesday. A member of the pastoral staff of Crossroads Baptist Church shares a message, and a staff member leads the students in praise and worship through music. Parents are welcome to attend. Parents are not required to get a visitor pass to attend Wednesday Chapel. Chapel is held at 8:35 AM for K3-K5 classes and at 9:05 AM for 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade.

### **Visitor's Pass**

Each time a parent visits the school/church campus, they are asked to secure a Visitor's Pass. Visitors are to sign-in at the school office and receive a pass. **The school asks parents to wear the pass so that it can be easily seen.** Parents are asked to sign-out when they leave the campus. This is a safety issue. **After the first day of school parents are asked not to walk their child to the classroom.** The school takes every measure to protect the academic instructional time.

## **Arrival & Dismissal**

Parents are requested to enter the campus from Eager Road and Exit onto Country Club. It is for the safety of our students and to reduce congestion on the campus. Students are considered tardy if they arrive after 8:15. Parents are to come into the office to sign in the student. Students are not to be checked out between 2:00 PM and 2:45 PM.

## **Early Arrival Program**

The EAP begins at 7:15 AM for parents who need to leave their children before the regular drop-off time which is 7:55 AM. The EAP program is managed by a staff member. The fees for Early Morning Arrival are listed below. There is no Registration Fee to sign up for the EAP; however, we ask that you do sign up in the office.

### **Fees for Early Arrival**

Monthly \$40.00	Due on the first day of the month.
Weekly \$12.00	Due the week of attendance.
Daily \$5.00	Due on the day the student participates in the program.

## **After School Program**

Crossroads offers an After-School Program that is available to any student who attends CBS. ASP time is 3:00-5:45 each day that CBS is in school. CBS employees staff the ASP program. In addition to an opportunity to work on homework, various activities are provided for student participation such as Art Club, Running Club, Lego's, and playtime. Students learn to interact with their peers in a fun, structured environment. Fees are based on the number of days that students stay. For more detail information related to ASP, parents may contact Christy Morse who manages the After-School Program.

## **Uniforms**

**Every day**, unless noted otherwise, is a uniform day. Uniform t-shirts and polo shirts are ordered three times a year: August, October, and May (for the upcoming year). The school office will send out information notifying parents of the order dates.

**Friday shirts are mandatory.** Friday shirts are ordered once a year at the beginning of the school term. Friday shirts are specially designed to be worn on Friday and designated events.

## **Basic Daily Attire**

- Crossroads uniform t-shirts are red, white, or navy **only** (ordered through the school). They have The Crossroads logo is on the shirt.
- Uniform t-shirts are defined as red, white, and navy t-shirts with the Crossroads Baptist School emblem on the left side. **A no-collared type t-shirt that does not have the CBS logo is not acceptable.**
- Polo type shirts are collared shirts that are **solid** or CBS polo. (CBS emblem only)
- Navy or khaki shorts, pants, skirts, skorts, or jumpers can be worn.
- Blue jean pants, blue jean shorts, blue jean capris, skirts, or skorts are acceptable. (denim material only)
- Closed toed shoes are to be worn always. Tennis shoes are to be worn on PE days.
