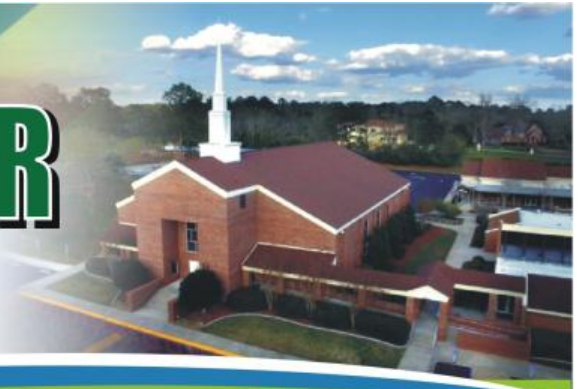

I AM EXCITED ABOUT OUR THREE UPCOMING "MARVELOUS MONDAYS IN JULY"!

These special summer worship celebrations are truly highlights of the year for us here at Crossroads.

Over the past twelve years we have hosted some really outstanding guest speakers during this annual series of power-packed services, and this year will be no different! Let me say just a word to you about the three men who will be our preachers for our "Marvelous Mondays," which begin in just a couple of weeks.

DR. DAVID LEAVELL: JULY 9 – Dr. Leavell is the Senior Pastor of the First Baptist Church in Millington, Tennessee. Last November he was elected President of the Tennessee Baptist Convention. I got to know David last summer in Phoenix, Arizona, as he and I served together on the Committee on Resolutions for the Southern Baptist Convention. He is a director of the Tennessee Baptist Mission Board, and a trustee of New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary, where his father, Dr. Landrum Leavell, served as president from 1975-94. Dr. David Leavell is widely known as an excellent preacher and evangelist.

REV. MIKE STONE: JULY 16 – Brother Mike is the Senior Pastor of Emmanuel Baptist Church in Blackshear, Georgia. Last November he was elected President of the Georgia Baptist Convention. Brother Mike and I have become good friends as we have served together on the Executive Committee of the Southern Baptist Convention. He was elected chairman of the SBC Executive Committee during our meeting in Dallas a couple of weeks ago. He has also served as the chairman of the Executive Committee of our Georgia Baptist Convention. Brother Mike is a frequent preacher at revivals and conferences across the southeast.

DR. STEPHEN RUMMAGE: JULY 23 – Dr. Rummage is the Senior Pastor of Bell Shoals Baptist Church in Brandon, Florida. He is currently serving his second term as president of the Florida Baptist Convention, and he just completed two years as the chairman of the Executive Committee of the Southern Baptist Convention. Dr. Rummage served as a professor of preaching at Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary for seven years, and he hosts a nationally broadcast radio program called

"Moving Forward." He has been elected to preach the annual convention sermon at the Southern Baptist Convention next summer in Birmingham, Alabama.

WE ARE TRULY HONORED TO HAVE THESE THREE BAPTIST STATE CONVENTION PRESIDENTS scheduled to be our guest preachers here at Crossroads for this year's "Marvelous Mondays in July"!
